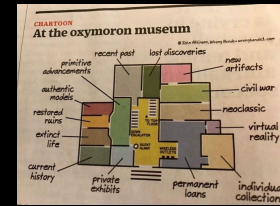

- Paralyzed patient
- Can not adequately ventilate without support
- Expect bleeding in the airway

Surgeries where a secured airway necessary

- Lefort
- BSSO
